

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2010-52 WHICH AUTHORIZED THE MAYOR TO PURCHASE POOL CHEMICALS FROM THE PATTERSON POOL COMPANIES THROUGH THE END OF THE 2010 SEASON FOR THE CITY OF BEACHWOOD FAMILY AQUATIC CENTER, AND FURTHER WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING

WHEREAS, the Community Services Director advises that The Patterson Pool Companies is the authorized PPG Accu-Tab distributor in Cuyahoga County; and

WHEREAS, based upon the recommendation of the Community Services Director as set forth in her Memorandum to the Mayor dated July 7, 2010, due to the warmer weather an additional 48 buckets of PPG Accu-Tab Chlorine tablets are needed and the Patterson Pool Companies has submitted a quotation for One Hundred Thirty Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents (\$130.25) per bucket for a total additional cost of Six Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Two Dollars and No/Cents (\$6,252.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Beachwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio:

Section 1: Based upon the recommendation of the Community Services Director, as set forth in her Memorandum to the Mayor dated July 7, 2010, the Mayor is hereby directed and authorized to issue a purchase order to The Patterson Pool Companies for an additional 48 buckets of PPG Accu-Tab Chlorine tablets for use at the Beachwood Family Aquatic Center for One Hundred Thirty Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents (\$130.25) per bucket for a total additional cost of Six Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Two Dollars and No/Cents (\$6,252.00), and further waiving competitive bidding.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions and deliberations of Council and its committees, relating to the passage of this legislation that resulted in formal action were in meetings open to the public where required by Chapter 105, Codified Ordinances of the City.

Section 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared an urgent measure which is immediately necessary for the public peace, health or safety or the efficient operation of the City, such necessity existing by reason of the immediate necessity of pool supplies/chemicals for the season.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
