ORDINANCE NO. 2010-13

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING PATRICIA A. VANEK AS ASSISTANT CLERK OF COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF BEACHWOOD, OHIO

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 4, and BCO Section 121.12, provide that the Council may appoint Assistant Clerks of Council to assist the Clerk and to act in the Clerk's absence.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Beachwood, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio that:

Section 1: Patricia A. Vanek be and she is appointed as Assistant Clerk of Council of the City of Beachwood in accordance with Article III, Section 4 of the Charter and BCO Section 121.12, effective January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2011, to perform any necessary duties of the Assistant Clerk of Council as provided by the Charter and laws of the City of Beachwood and the laws of the State of Ohio.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions and deliberations of Council and its committees relating to the passage of this legislation that resulted in formal action were in meetings open to the public where required by Chapter 105 of the Codified Ordinances of the City.

Section 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an urgent measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and welfare; such necessity existing for the reason that the employment provided herein is needed for the proper operation of an essential Department of the City government; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon its enactment and approval by the Mayor.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
