

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE POSITION DESCRIPTION OF ASSISTANT FIRE CHIEF FOR THE CITY OF BEACHWOOD AND AMENDING SCHEDULE D OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE SALARY ORDINANCE TO INCLUDE THE SAME

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2005 Council adopted Ordinance No. 2005-138 accepting Employee Position Descriptions for the Administrative Staff of the City of Beachwood; and

WHEREAS, on February 4, 2010, the Finance Director recommended to the Mayor, that the City add the Assistant Fire Chief position pursuant to BCO Section 147.01, along with the amendment of Schedule D of the Administrative Salary Ordinance to include the same.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY the Council of the City of Beachwood, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio.

Section 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to adopt the attached employee position description to add the position of Assistant Fire Chief to the City of Beachwood and to amend Schedule D to include the same as attached hereto. Said position description may be modified or amended from time to time with the approval of the Mayor and the Fire Chief.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions and deliberations of Council and its committees, relating to the passage of this legislation that resulted in formal action were in meetings open to the public where required by Chapter 105, Codified Ordinances of the City.

Section 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared an urgent measure which is immediately necessary for the public peace, health, or safety or the efficient operation of the City; and for the further reason of the immediate necessity of providing appropriate terms and conditions, organizational chart and pay grade/ranges for City employees and elected officials who are not members of a collective bargaining unit.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
