ORDINANCE NO. 2010-38

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF BPI INFORMATION SYSTEMS FOR THE PURCHASE OF 650 HOURS OF BLOCK TIME SUPPORT.

WHEREAS, BPI Information Systems has presented a proposal to provide ongoing support of the City's Computer Network, and

WHEREAS, Council desires to accept the proposal of BPI Information Systems for the purchase of 650 hours of block time support at \$85.00 per hour for a total cost not to exceed Fifty-Five Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars and NO/100 Cents (\$55,250.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Beachwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio:

Section 1: Based upon the recommendation of the Audit Director in his Memorandum to the Mayor dated February 8, 2010, the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to accept the proposal of BPI Information Systems for the purchase of 650 hours of block time support at \$85.00 per hour for a total cost not to exceed Fifty-Five Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars and NO/100 Cents (\$55,250.00).

Section 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an urgent measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare or the efficient operation of the City; such necessity existing by reason of the immediate necessity of determining the City's computer needs.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
