

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A RENEWAL CONTRACT WITH CINTAS CORPORATION FOR THE RENTAL OF SERVICE DEPARTMENT UNIFORMS, FENDER COVERS, HALLWAY MATS (VARIOUS SIZES), AND POLICE DEPARTMENT BLANKETS AND COVERALLS

WHEREAS, the City has previously contracted with Cintas Corporation for the purchase of Service Department uniforms, fender covers, hallway mats (various sizes), and Police Department blankets and coveralls.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Beachwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: Based upon the recommendation of the Service Director in his Memorandum to the Mayor dated March 22, 2010, the Mayor is authorized to enter into a renewal contract for twenty-four (24) months with Cintas Corporation for Service Department uniforms, fender covers, hallway mats (various sizes), and Police Department blankets and coveralls as set forth on the bid proposal attached hereto and incorporated by reference for a renewal term of twenty-four (24) months, and the Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Beachwood with said company, without advertising further for competitive bids.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions and deliberations of Council and its committees relating to the passage of this legislation that resulted in formal action were in meetings open to the public where required by Chapter 105 of the Codified Ordinances of the City.

Section 3: This Ordinance is declared to be an urgent measure which is immediately necessary for the public peace, health or safety or the efficient operation of the City; and for the further reason of the need to purchase these items for the optimum operation of the Service Department and Police Department staff.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
