

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO PARTICIPATE IN A CONSORTIUM TO INVITE PROPOSALS FOR RECYCLING PROCESSING SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District offered to facilitate the creation of a consortium including the City of Beachwood, the City of Cleveland Heights, the City of Independence, the City of Lyndhurst, the Village of Moreland Hills, the City of Pepper Pike, the City of Shaker Heights, the City of South Euclid, the City of University Heights, the City of Warrensville Heights and the Village of Woodmere in order to obtain recycling processing services for the participants in the consortium; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District has offered to prepare the request for proposals and contract documents to invite proposals for the simultaneous award of a contract for Recycling Processing Services, including a recommendation by the consortium regarding the successful proposal for consideration by each of the participants in the consortium; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Beachwood has determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Beachwood and its residents to participate in the consortium and authorizes the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District, by and on behalf of the City of Beachwood and the other participants in the consortium, to advertise and Invite Proposals for the Recycling Processing Services required by the City of Beachwood.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Beachwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio that:

Section 1: The Council of the City of Beachwood hereby approves the participation of the City of Beachwood in a consortium to obtain proposals for recycling processing services. The Council of the City of Beachwood further authorizes Dale Pekarek, Service Director, to meet with the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District and the participants in the consortium for the development of proposal documents and the review and recommendation to the City of Beachwood of the successful contractor. The City reserves the right to reject the selection of any proposal and to elect not to participate further in the consortium. The Council of the City of Beachwood authorizes the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District to attach a copy of this Resolution as an exhibit to the request for proposals to demonstrate that the City of Beachwood authorized participation in the consortium.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions and deliberations of Council and its committees relating to the passage of this legislation that resulted in formal action were in meetings open to the public where required by Chapter 105 of the Codified Ordinances of the City.

Section 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an urgent measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, or safety or for the efficient operation of the City and to further review proposals for recycling processing services.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
