ORDINANCE NO. 2010-67

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL TO BECOME A SILVER SPONSOR FOR THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF INDUSTRIAL AND OFFICE PROPERTIES (NAIOP) ANNUAL AWARDS OF EXCELLENCE

WHEREAS, once a year NAIOP has an "Awards of Excellence" where quality development projects in Northeast Ohio are recognized; and

WHEREAS, Developers Diversified Realty's new building in the City of Beachwood has been nominated for Office Development Project of the Year and Interior Design Project of the Year; and

WHEREAS, the Economic Development Director has accordingly recommended that the City of Beachwood become A Silver Sponsor at One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for the NAIOP Annual Awards of Excellence.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Beachwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized on behalf of the City of Beachwood to become a Silver Sponsor for the NAIOP Annual Awards of Excellence in an amount not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions and deliberations of Council and its committees relating to the passage of this legislation that resulted in formal action were in meetings open to the public where required by Chapter 105 of the Codified Ordinances of the City.

Section 3: This Ordinance is declared to be an urgent measure which is immediately necessary for the public peace, health or safety or the efficient operation of the City; and for the further reason to promote Economic Development within the City of Beachwood.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
