RE: Duffield Road White Topping

Dear Resident:

I am pleased to inform you Duffield Road is scheduled for improvements this spring. The Duffield Road White Topping Project from Sulgrave Oval to Wimbledon Road is scheduled to start the week of May 5th. The work will be done at no cost to you. The prime Contractor, Tri-Mor Construction Company, will notify you prior to and periodically during construction to advise you of their work schedule and maintenance of traffic issues. The project is scheduled to be completed within 35 working days of the start of construction depending on weather and any unforeseen conditions.

The general scope of work is as follows:

- Milling of approximately 3.5 inches off the existing asphalt pavement surface
- Replacement of existing curbs and driveway aprons with new concrete curbs and aprons
- Concrete white topping over the remaining asphalt pavement

In order to expedite the project and to provide a safe work zone for both vehicular traffic and construction work, Duffield Road will be limited to one-way traffic for the duration of the project. Westbound traffic will be maintained at all times. A designated detour route will be posted for eastbound traffic. The westbound only traffic will allow City safety forces to quickly access your neighborhood.

Residents should have access to their driveways until concrete pavement, curbs, and drive aprons are installed. A temporary stone drive apron will be installed as your concrete apron is removed. Once all preparation work is completed, the Contractor will begin concrete pavement preparation and paving for one side of the street at a time. At that time, residents on the side of the street being paved will not have access to their driveways. During that period, you may park your vehicles on adjoining side streets. As an alternative, it is recommended you make arrangements with your neighbors on the opposite side of the street to temporarily park in their driveway. This favor could then be returned when your neighbor's side of the street is being paved. The Contractor will be giving you further notifications regarding driveway access limitations. A notice will be sent to your residence one week prior to driveway work beginning on your side of the street.

Emergency vehicles-Police, Fire, and Fire Rescue-will have access to your residence at all times.
