

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PERMIT THE USAGE OF THE BEACHWOOD COMMUNITY CENTER BY THE CLEVELAND HEIGHTS/ UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS ADULT BASIC AND LITERACY EDUCATION (ABLE) PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2010-116, adopted on August 16, 2010, provides that non-profit community organizations may use the Beachwood Community Center no more than once per quarter; and

WHEREAS, the non-profit Cleveland Heights/University Heights Adult Basic and Literacy Education (ABLE) Program has requested the use of the Beachwood Community Center on October 7, 21, and 28; November 4, 11, and 18; December 2, 9, and 16; and January 6, 13, 20 and 27, because their normal meeting space at the Beachwood Public Library is not be available because of the library construction project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Beachwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to approve the use of the Beachwood Community Center by the non-profit Cleveland Heights/University Heights Adult Basic and Literacy Education (ABLE) Program on the following dates October 7, 21, and 28; November 4, 11, and 18; December 2, 9, and 16; and January 6, 13, 20 and 27,

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions and deliberations of Council and its committees, relating to the passage of this legislation, that resulted in formal action, were in meetings open to the public where required by Chapter 105, Codified Ordinances of the City.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency or urgent measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health or safety or the efficient operation of the City; and for the further reason that it is necessary to accommodate this non-profit organization.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force for all bookings after the passage of this Ordinance.
