ORDINANCE NO. 2011-125

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2011-106 TO INCREASE THE CITY'S SHARE OF THE CHAGRIN BOULEVARD ITS PROJECT COST.

WHEREAS, Council previously approved Final Resolution 2011-16 and amended Ordinance 2011-31 approving cooperation with the Ohio Department of Transportation for a new central based control system for nine intersections along Chagrin Boulevard and one intersection at Richmond Road/Bryden Road, lying within the City of Beachwood ("Chagrin Boulevard ITS Project"); and

WHEREAS, Council previously approved Ordinance No. 2011-49 amending Ordinance No. 2011-31 to provide for an increase of the City's share of the Chagrin Boulevard ITS Project; and

WHEREAS, such increase was necessitated by an error in the bid award amount provided by the Ohio Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2011-49 authorized an increase in the amount of Forty-One Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Seven Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$41,997.50), bringing the City's total share of the cost to Three Hundred Four Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Seven Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$304,677.50); and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2011-106 authorized the Ohio Department of Transportation to increase the number of fiber strands along Chagrin Boulevard from eighteen (18) to one hundred forty-four (144) for an additional cost of Twenty-Seven Thousand Four Hundred Ninety-One Dollars and Sixty-Nine Cents (\$27,491.69) bringing the City's total share of the cost to Three Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand One Hundred Sixty-Nine Dollars and Nineteen Cents (\$332,169.19); and

WHEREAS, the City is requesting ODOT to add two (2) additional items of work to the Chagrin ITS project: 1) the replacement of the US Bank Building (24700 Chagrin Boulevard) drive apron on Chagrin Boulevard east of Mercantile Road, at a price of Nine Thousand Three Hundred Eleven Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$9,311.50), 100% of which is at the City's cost; and 2) for the safety of motorists, that the contractor perform some items of work during night hours, at an extra cost for night work of Ten Thousand Dollars and No/Cents (\$10,000.00), which item is project eligible with an 80/20 split, making the City's cost estimated at Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the total cost for the two items of additional work to be performed by ODOT for the Chagrin ITS Project is Eleven Thousand Three Hundred Eleven Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$11,311.50) bringing the City's total share of the cost to Four Hundred Forty-Three Thousand Four Hundred Eighty Dollars and Sixty-Nine Cents (\$443,480.69).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Beachwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio:

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-125

Section 1: Based upon the recommendation of the Staff Engineer in his Memorandum to the Mayor dated September 23, 2011, Council hereby authorizes an increase of the City's share of the Chagrin Boulevard ITS Project cost in the amount of Eleven Thousand Three Hundred Eleven Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$11,311.50) bringing the City's total share of the cost to Four Hundred Forty-Three Thousand Four Hundred Eighty Dollars and Sixty-Nine Cents (\$443,480.69).

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions and deliberations of Council and its committees relating to the passage of this legislation that resulted in formal action were in meetings open to the public where required by Chapter 105 of the Codified Ordinances of the City.

Section 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared an urgent measure which is immediately necessary for the public peace, health or safety or the efficient operation of the City; and for the further reason that the completion of this work is necessary for the safety of the motorists.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
