

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO PATROLMEN’S BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION (DISPATCHERS/CLERKS)

WHEREAS, the Mayor has approved a proposed new Contract effective November 1, 2011 through October 31, 2014 with the Ohio Patrolmen’s Benevolent Association (Dispatcher/Clerk), which has been ratified and approved by the members of the Union and is now submitted to the Council for its consideration and approval; and

WHEREAS, the terms and conditions of the contract are fair and reasonable to all parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Beachwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into and execute a new Contract on behalf of the City effective November 1, 2011 through October 31, 2014 with the Ohio Patrolmen’s Benevolent Association (Dispatcher/Clerk), as set forth in the Contract, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference as if fully rewritten herein.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions and deliberations of Council and its committees, relating to the passage of this legislation that resulted in formal action were in meetings open to the public where required by Chapter 105, Codified Ordinances of the City.

Section 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an urgent measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, or safety or the efficient operation of the City and for the further reason that it is necessary to approve the said contracts promptly as required by the Ohio SERB laws.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
