

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BRAD SELLERS FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF BEACHWOOD BEGINNING MAY 23, 2011 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2011

WHEREAS, the Economic Development Committee has recommended utilizing Brad Sellers for professional services as an Economic Development Consultant; and

WHEREAS, the City accordingly desires to authorize a contract between the City and Brad Sellers at a cost of Sixty-Two Thousand Dollars and No/Cents (\$62,000.00) plus reimbursable expenses (mileage and travel) as outlined in the Proposal attached hereto and incorporated herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Beachwood, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Brad Sellers for professional services as an Economic Development Consultant at a cost of Sixty-Two Thousand Dollars and No/Cents (\$62,000.00) beginning May 23, 2011 through December 31, 2011, plus reimbursable expenses (mileage and travel) as outlined in the Proposal attached hereto and incorporated herein

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions and deliberations of Council and its committees relating to the passage of this legislation that resulted in formal action were in meetings open to the public where required by Chapter 105 of the Codified Ordinances of the City.

Section 3: This Ordinance is declared to be an urgent measure which is immediately necessary for the public peace, health or safety or the efficient operation of the City; and such necessity for professional communication services.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
