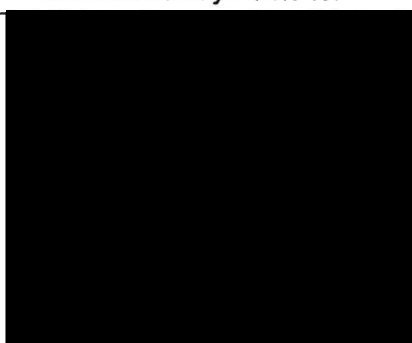

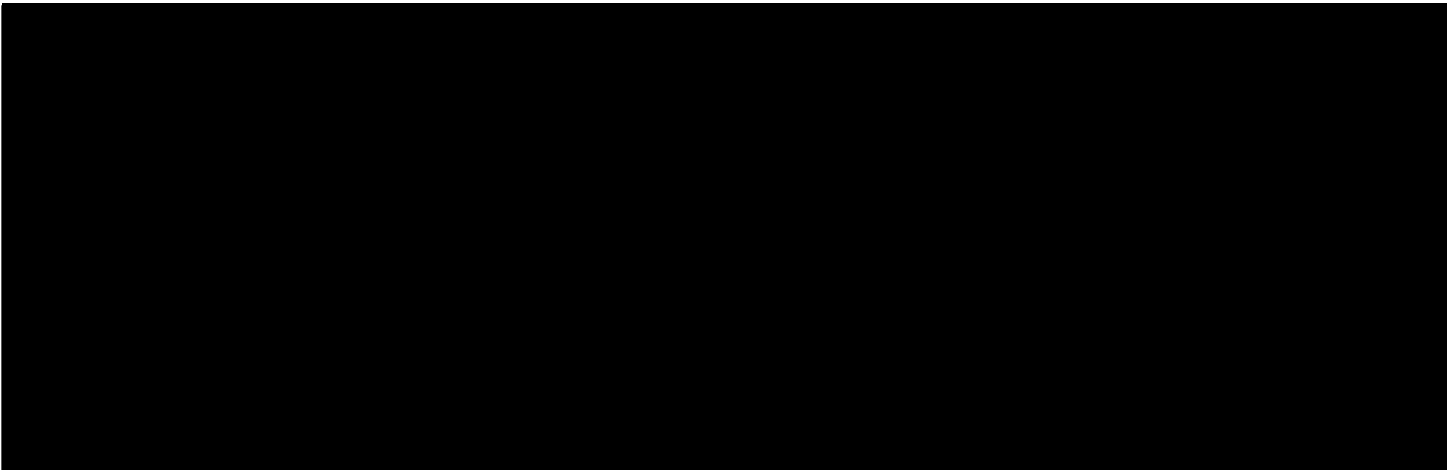

Section 3: The City Council of City of Beachwood, Ohio authorizes the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District to attach a copy of this Resolution as an exhibit to the request for proposals to demonstrate that the City of Beachwood, Ohio authorized participation in the consortium.

Section 4: It is found and determined that all formal actions and deliberations of Council and its committees, relating to the passage of this legislation that resulted in formal action were in meetings open to the public where required by Chapter 105 of the Codified Ordinances of the City.

Section 5: This Resolution is declared an urgent measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or the efficient operation of the City, and for the further reason that the City may participate in competitive bidding; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
