


In which area of Beachwood do you live?


- **North:** Between Cedar Road and Fairmount Boulevard – **61%**
- **Middle:** Between Fairmount Boulevard and S. Woodland Road – **25%**
- **South:** Between S. Woodland Road and Harvard Road – **14%**




If you have concerns about the deer in Beachwood, please indicate those concerns. You can choose more than one answer.



We have been conducting a culling program for the past 3 years. How do you feel about the effectiveness of the program?

- Very Effective – **21%**
- Somewhat Effective – **38%**
- Not Effective – **23%**
- Not Sure – **18%**





Which option do you prefer for deer population control moving forward?

- **Immediate results:** I prefer strategies that lead to quick, noticeable, reductions in the deer population (culling/lethal removal) – **34%**
- **Long-term results:** I prefer strategies that provide more sustainable, long-term solutions (sterilization) – **21%**
- I am open to both approaches, depending on cost and circumstances – **36%**
- I prefer no culling or sterilization methods. I believe the deer population should be left to grow naturally. – **9%**

Considering the cost factors, which of the following do you prefer?

- A mix of both methods depending on cost and effectiveness – **59%**
- Not willing to support any significant cost increase – **28%**
- Against any form of deer population control – **13%**
