**Beachwood Police Department Rolls Out First All-Electric Patrol Vehicle
Ahead of National Night Out Event**

Beachwood, Ohio (7/24/25)— The City of Beachwood and the Beachwood Police Department announce the deployment of the department's first-ever all-electric patrol vehicle. The high-performance Ford Mustang Mach-E has officially joined the city's traffic enforcement fleet, marking a milestone in sustainability and innovation for the community.

This sleek, fully electric vehicle has been specially outfitted for active police duty and selected for its proven reliability, advanced safety features, and ability to meet the rigorous demands of law enforcement. To the department's knowledge, this is the first Mach-E deployed as a police cruiser in Northeast Ohio.

"This is more than just a car—it's a commitment to our increased traffic enforcement efforts and the future," said Beachwood Police Chief Daniel Grispingo. "The Mustang Mach-E will reduce our department's carbon footprint, lower operating costs, and show our community that innovation and public service go hand in hand."

"Chief Grispingo's leadership is driving advancements in public safety for Beachwood," said Mayor Justin Berns. "This electric patrol vehicle reflects his responsiveness to community feedback regarding traffic enforcement, while embracing innovation and sustainability."
