PARENTS, GUARDIANS AND CAMPERS:

Welcome to the Beachwood Kidz Day Camp Summer 2019!

Our camp is scheduled to run from June 10th through July 26th ... that's 34 days and over 200 hours of summer fun, games, field trips and most importantly, great memories!

No camp on Thursday, July 4th.

Please familiarize yourself with the following rules and procedures designed to guarantee a wonderful camp experience.

MORNING ARRIVAL – CURBSIDE DROP-OFF

Our day begins at 9:00 a.m., Monday through Friday. Our drop off will be at the High School main parking lot. You can drop off your child from 8:45-9:00 a.m. We will have adults outside opening doors and escorting your camper inside to camp. If you need to speak to a staff member, please park in the main school parking lot and walk in with your camper. You can always park in the main school parking lot to walk your child inside if preferred.

AFTERNOON PICK-UP

Our day ends at 3:15 p.m. You can begin pick-up at 3:00.

Parents need to pick-up campers from their camp rooms. Unfortunately, we are unable to do curbside pick-up. Each counselor will have a sign out list in their room. Please send a note in the morning if your child is going home with another camper.

Siblings: if you have more than one child attending Kidz Camp, they will be paired together at the end of the day and be ready for pick up in the youngest child's age group.

CARPOOL

If your child is going home with a friend or has another ride, please send a note to camp in the morning. **We will not permit children to go home with anyone without a written note from the guardian or parent of both children.**

Permission Release of a child: Enclosed is a release form. Please list the people who have permission to take your child home from camp. We ask if your child has a playdate please notify the camp via letter. We will not release your child without written permission.

LATE PICK-UP / AFTER CAMP CHILD CARE

After 3:30 p.m., any camper not picked up will be escorted to Beachwood Recreation After Camp Child Care. On warm days, the After Camp Child Care will be held at the Beachwood Family Aquatic Center. On bad weather days, it will be held at Beachwood High School. A late pick-up fee of \$5 will be charged for every 15 minutes you arrive beyond 3:30 p.m. The late pick-up fee must be paid when picking up your child or before your child returns to camp the following day. No exceptions permitted.

If your child is signed up for After Camp Child Care and is not going, please contact the camp office in the morning. If we do not hear from you, your child will be sent to After Camp Child Care.

BEFORE AND AFTER CAMP CHILD CARE

This program operates from 7:00 a.m. until 9:15 a.m. at the Beachwood High School Cafeteria and resumes again from 3:00 p.m. until 6:15 p.m.

If you are interested in using this program you must make arrangements by 4:30 p.m. the Wednesday prior to the week of service by calling the Camp Child Care Reservation Phone Line at (216) 292-1943 with credit card information. Forms may also be faxed to (216) 292-1976 or placed in the black after hour drop box located outside the Community Center entrance. Forms are available on-line at www.beachwoodohio.com. DROP INS ARE NOT PERMITTED.

7:00 a.m. – 9:15 a.m. \$11 per day
3:00 p.m. – 6:15 p.m. \$14 per day

All Camp Child Care fees must be paid in full by 4:30 p.m. on the Wednesday prior to services or fees will be doubled. Repeated late requests may result in denied future childcare requests.

Late registration fees (Arrangements made after Wednesday):

7:00 a.m. – 9:15 a.m. \$22 per day
3:00 p.m. – 6:15 p.m. \$28 per day

Unused but paid fees are not carried over to another week and are non-refundable. If your child is scheduled to attend either Before or After Camp Child Care and you have a change in plans, please call the Recreation Office ahead of time at (216) 292-1970.

ABSENCES

If a camper will be absent for any reason, please call the Kidz Camp Office BEFORE 9:30 a.m. at (216) 292-1974. Please leave your child's full name, group name and the reason they will not be attending. If absence is due to a communicable disease, please be sure to inform us so we can send home the proper paperwork. If your child is arriving late, please be sure to call as well. All late arrivals need to be walked into the Kidz Camp Office.

MEDICATIONS

If your child requires any medication prescribed by a physician during camp hours, please bring all medication to the Kidz Camp Office. Everything must be properly labeled with dosage and timing instructions.

Medication forms must be completed at beachwoodohio.com and submitted to campforms@beachwoodohio.com before any medication is distributed. See Camp Director if you have any questions.

Please alert the Camp Director of any allergies both verbally and in writing. If medication is needed for allergies please label the medication and bring it to the Kidz Camp Office.

Beginning 2019, Beachwood Camps will employ a nurse to oversee all of our summer camps. The Camp Nurse administers all medications to campers and assesses and monitors any health concerns that may arise during the day.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The City of Beachwood Recreation Department would like your child to have the best experience possible while at camp this summer. Thus, all participants must understand and follow the camp guidelines and rules. These guidelines and expectations are in place to ensure the safety of your child and staff.

1. Respect of surroundings, staff and each other.
2. No physical or emotional violence will be tolerated.
3. All campers should remain with their counselors unless given permission.
4. Keep hands, feet and other objects to yourself. If it's not yours, don't touch it.
5. Participate in camp activities.
6. No electronics permitted at camp. Cell phones must remain in bag until end of day.
7. Follow staff instructions.
8. Be positive and HAVE FUN!

We are NOT responsible for any lost or damaged video games or electronics. In an effort to prevent problems we ask that your child leave these items at home.

BEHAVIOR POLICY

1st Degree Offense

Behaviors but not limited to:

- *Not listening to counselors, showing respect or talking back to counselors
- *Minor pushing or shoving
- *Not following directions

Consequences

- Step 1:** Time out/Removal from activity
- Step 2:** Verbal Warning and removed from activity
- Step 3:** Parents contacted Removal from Activity
- Step 4:** Parents contacted and removed from group for portion of day
- Step 5:** Parent contacted and 1 day suspension

2nd Degree Offense

Behavior but not limited to:

- *Instigating
- *Bullying
- *Inappropriate Language
- *Leaving group without permission
- *Blatant disrespect
- *Continual pushing/shoving

Consequences

- Step 1:** Removal from activity
- Step 2:** Parents Contacted and Removed from group
- Step 3:** 1 Day Suspension
- Step 4:** 3 Day Suspension
- Step 5:** 5 Day Suspension or Expulsion and possible forfeiture of camp fees

3rd Degree Offense

Behavior but not limited to:

- * A threat to others or themselves
- * Continual aggressive behavior
- * Abuse/Harassment
- * Destruction of property
- * Physical Fight
- * Having a weapon in possession
- *Stealing

Consequences

- Step 1:** Removed from group and parent contacted
- Step 2:** 3-5 Day suspension depending on incident
- Step 3:** Expulsion from camp and forfeiture of camp fees

LIP SYNC TALENT SHOW

Mark the date on your calendars! The entire camp will entertain you on Thursday, July 18 at 6:30 p.m. at Beachwood High School. The whole family is invited.

SWIM LESSONS

Campers will be tested and placed at their appropriate swim level. Every child will be given a waterproof bracelet to be worn daily at the pool. The children will not be permitted to use the diving boards, vortex, water slides or areas of the pool deeper than 3 feet.

If there is a field trip during the week, swim lessons will be held on Fridays.

****Please make sure your child has a swimsuit and towel in their bag daily along with a labeled sunscreen bottle. We will keep the sunscreen at Kidz Camp. We will apply sunscreen before entering the water. Please send an extra t-shirt in your child's bag if you want them to wear it in the water.**

Please send a zip lock bag to put your child's wet swimsuit in daily. This way all their items won't get wet inside their back packs.

Swim lessons will be Mondays and Wednesdays for 45 minutes from 9:45-10:30 2nd grade, 10:35-11:20 Kindergarten, 11:25-12:10 1st Grade.

SNACK SCHEDULE

Each camper is designated a day or two to supply snack for their group. Your date will be sent home on a calendar. Please read the calendar and check for allergies in your group. We have a fridge and freezer available for snacks only. We always encourage healthy snacks.

Please provide a peanut free snack. Due to allergies, please provide only store bought snacks.

LUNCH

Campers are required to bring their lunch daily. Please note we DO NOT have a refrigerator or heating available for lunches. Please send an extra water bottle with your child on hot days.

The Concession Stand at the Aquatic Center is not available for Kidz Campers.

LABELING

Be sure to label towels, backpacks, lunch bags, sunscreen, water bottles and other personal items. (i.e. underwear, socks, hats, etc.).

Send in a labeled zip lock bag with an extra set of clothes for Kindergarteners to keep at camp.

FIELD TRIPS

Attached is a list of planned field trips and special camp events. Campers MUST wear socks, tennis shoes and their camp t-shirts on every field trip.

*** Be sure to send lunches in a disposable brown or plastic bag to throw away on field trips.

*** Make sure campers arrive on time on field trip days as buses leave promptly.

A few of our field trips require waivers, please go on-line and complete the waiver previous to field trip dates. If you have already attended the venue you are waived in and do not need to resubmit.

Frequently Asked Questions

How should I dress my camper?

Your campers will be outside and inside each day. We do many activities outside. Please make sure your camper has a pair of tennis shoes that are comfortable to run in and for play on the playground. Water shoes to wear back and forth to the pool are acceptable too.

What should I pack in my child's book bag daily?

In addition to a lunch, (no refrigeration is available so use ice packs), a towel and bathing suit should be packed daily. Sunscreen is kept in the classroom.

What should I leave in the camp room on the first day?

In a separate bag, provide a towel, extra change of clothing and sunscreen. Any medications should be brought to the camp office. Please label everything.

What is a good group snack idea?

Fruit, hummus and carrots, pretzels, popsicles, crackers, cheese sticks,

Will sunscreen be applied at camp?

Sunscreen should be applied at home. If you have signed the sunscreen release, your child's camp counselor will reapply the sunscreen to your child two times daily. Please make sure your child has a labeled sunscreen at camp (no spray sunscreen, please provide lotion only).

What should my camper bring on Field Trip Days?

Your camper should wear their supplied camp t-shirt and bring a brown bag disposable lunch on field trip days. Please have your camper wear tennis shoes.
