SCARECROW GUIDELINES

- Select materials that can withstand the elements.
- Scarecrows will be on display until October 31. Any salvageable items will be donated to the Beachwood Community Theater program.
- All stuffing, twine and mounting posts will be supplied.
- Participants need to supply clothing, accessories and creativity!
- Suggestions for scarecrow head – pantyhose, pillowcases, small flour bag.
- Suggestive items to bring with you: scissors, scarecrow clothes, safety pins, clothespins, ribbon or a belt, stapler with staples, news paper.
- Suggestions for scarecrow hair – yarn, old mop, rope, ribbon, old wig
- Suggestions for scarecrow accessories – gloves, old hats.
- Unique costumes, faces, accessories and very sturdy construction are encouraged.
- No edible or perishable accessories.
- No electric or motorized moving parts.
- No political or social issues permitted.
