

The Assistant Law Director/Prosecutor serves as legal counsel for the City's administration both civilly and criminally. On the civil side, the Assistant Law Director's duties include reviewing and redacting public records in compliance with applicable Ohio law, researching and writing legal opinions to assist the Mayor, Council and city departments, assisting in contract negotiations and responding to constituent questions and issues. On the criminal side, the Prosecutor reviews criminal charges for probable cause determinations, represents the City of Beachwood in Shaker Heights Municipal Court, negotiates the resolution of cases in Beachwood Mayor's Court and provides legal advice and assistance to the Beachwood Police Department.

Nathalie Supler has served as the Assistant Law Director/Prosecutor since August 2017. Prior to joining the City of Beachwood, Nathalie was an Assistant Prosecuting Attorney in Cuyahoga County.
