PARENTS, GUARDIANS AND CAMPERS:

Welcome to the Beachwood Recreation Theater Camp 2021!

Our camp is scheduled to run from June 14th through July 30th ...that's 34 days and tons of hours of summer fun, workshops, showcases, performances and most importantly – great memories!

No camp on Monday, July 5th .

Please familiarize yourself with the following guidelines designed to guarantee an **OUTSTANDING** camp experience.

MORNING ARRIVAL – CURBSIDE DROP-OFF

Our day begins at 9:00 a.m., Monday through Friday. You may drop your child off between 8:45 a.m. – 9:00 a.m. Campers are to go directly to the Theatre Camp area which is the Middle School Auditorium. There will be camp counselors outside to monitor.

AFTERNOON PICK-UP

Our day ends at 3:30 p.m.

Campers will be walked to the Middle School circular drive for pick-up. You may either park in the lot and walk to retrieve your child or remain in your car and pull around the circular drive for curbside pickup. Campers will not be permitted to walk through the parking lot without an adult.

WALKERS AND BIKE RIDERS

If your camper has permission to walk or ride a bicycle to and from camp, you are required to complete a consent form. These forms are available online at beachwoodohio.com.

Note: Bike helmets are required by law in the City of Beachwood.

BEFORE AND AFTER CAMP CHILD CARE

This program operates from 7:00 a.m. until 9:15 a.m. at Beachwood High School Cafeteria and resumes again from 3:00 p.m. until 6:15 p.m.

If you are interested in using this program you must make arrangements by 4:30p.m. the Wednesday prior to the week of interest by calling the Camp Child Care Reservation Phone Line at (216) 292-1943 with credit card information or by registering online at Beachwoodohio.com/registration. **DROP INS ARE NOT PERMITTED.**

7:00 a.m. – 9:15 a.m. \$12 per day
3:00 p.m. – 6:15 p.m. \$15 per day

All Camp Child Care fees must be paid in full by 4:30 p.m. on the Wednesday prior to services or fees will be doubled. Repeated late requests may result in denied future childcare requests.

Late registration fees (Arrangements made after Wednesday):

7:00 a.m. – 9:15 a.m. \$24 per day
3:00 p.m. – 6:15 p.m. \$30 per day

Unused but paid fees are not carried over to another week and are non-refundable. If your child is scheduled to attend either Before or After Camp Child Care and you have a change in plans, please call the Recreation Office ahead of time at (216) 292-1970.

ABSENCES

If a camper will be absent for any reason, please call the Theater Camp Office BEFORE 9:30 a.m. at (216) 595-5498. Please leave your child's full name and the reason they will not be attending. If absence is due to a communicable disease, please be sure to inform us so we can send home the proper paper work. Session I concludes with a large, all-camp production **we do expect all campers to be present for all performances** scheduled in order to receive a speaking role.

If your child is arriving late, please be sure to call as well. All late arrivals will need to be walked to the Theater Camp Office.

***COVID PROTOCOLS:**

If your child is not feeling well we ask that they stay home until all symptoms are gone. If your child has tested positive for COVID, call the Recreation Department at 216-292-1970 to report so the proper measures can be taken.

MEDICATIONS

If your child requires any medication prescribed by a physician during camp hours, please make sure all medications are handed in prior to the start of camp. This includes allergy medication, inhalers and any pills. Everything must be properly labeled with dosage and timing instructions in the original packaging.

Please alert the Camp Director of any medical issues both verbally and in writing.

Medication forms must be completed prior to the disbursement of medication. Forms were in your camp packets or can be obtained from the Recreation office or the Camp Director.

If medication is needed contact Shannon at the Community Services office to make arrangements to drop off your campers medication prior to the start of camp.

Beachwood Camps will employ a nurse to oversee all of our summer camps. The Camp Nurse administers all medications to campers and assesses and monitors any health concerns that may arise during the day.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The City of Beachwood Recreation Department would like your child to have the best experience possible while at camp this summer. Thus, all participants must understand and follow the camp guidelines and rules. These guidelines and expectations are in place to ensure the safety of your child and staff.

1. Respect of surroundings, staff and each other.
2. No physical or emotional violence will be tolerated.
3. All campers should remain with their counselors unless given permission.
4. Keep hands, feet and other objects to yourself. If it's not yours, don't touch it.
5. Participate in camp activities.
6. No electronics permitted at camp. Cell phones must remain in bag until end of day. Exceptions made for recording devices.
7. Follow staff instructions.
8. Be positive and HAVE FUN!

We are NOT responsible for any lost or damaged video games or electronics. In an effort to prevent problems we ask that your child leave these items at home.

BEHAVIOR POLICY

1st Degree Offense

Behaviors but not limited to:

- *Not listening to counselors, showing respect or talking back to counselors
- *Minor pushing or shoving
- *Not following directions

Consequences

- Step 1:** Time out/Removal from activity
- Step 2:** Verbal Warning and removed from activity
- Step 3:** Parents contacted Removal from Activity
- Step 4:** Parents contacted and removed from group for portion of day
- Step 5:** Parent contacted and 1 day suspension

2nd Degree Offense

Behavior but not limited to:

- *Instigating
- *Bullying
- *Inappropriate Language
- *Leaving group without permission
- *Blatant disrespect
- *Continual pushing/shoving

Consequences

- Step 1:** Removal from activity
- Step 2:** Parents Contacted and Removed from group
- Step 3:** 1 Day Suspension
- Step 4:** 3 Day Suspension
- Step 5:** 5 Day Suspension or Expulsion and possible forfeiture of camp fees

3rd Degree Offense

Behavior but not limited to:

- * A threat to others or themselves
- * Continual aggressive behavior
- * Abuse/Harassment
- * Destruction of property
- * Physical Fight
- * Having a weapon in possession
- *Stealing

Consequences

- Step 1:** Removed from group and parent contacted
- Step 2:** 3-5 Day suspension depending on incident
- Step 3:** Expulsion from camp and forfeiture of camp fees

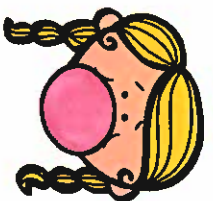
