



## **RULES & REGULATIONS**

Welcome! The Beachwood Family Aquatic Center is a very large and exciting facility. Our primary goal is to ensure a safe and pleasant experience. Please read our guest rules that are designed with your safety in mind.

- All patrons require a daily admission or have a current season pass.
- Children 12 and under must be accompanied and supervised by a person age 16 or older.
- All guests must be attired in a swimsuit (religious exceptions are allowed). No thongs or jean shorts allowed. For the safety of our guests, swim diapers are required. Regular diapers are prohibited.
- Admission to the facility may be denied for any of the following reasons:
  - Suspicion that the guest is under the influence of alcohol or drugs
  - Evidence that a guest has a contagious disease
  - Evidence of open wounds
  - Guest not having proper swim attire
- Maximum of 6 guest per household per day.
- No outside food or beverage permitted with the exception of water.
- Abusive or profane language to guests or towards the Beachwood Family Aquatic Center staff will not be tolerated. Guests will be asked to leave if using abusive or profane language.
- Cigarettes, vaping, e-cigs, chewing tobacco, alcoholic beverages, lighters and any illegal substances are not allowed inside the facility, on the playground, or immediately outside the main pool entrance.
- No running on pool deck.
- Changing diapers should be handled in the locker room.
- Guests are not allowed to swim for 24 hours after last episode of diarrhea.
- All guests must use locker room areas to change; no changing on the pool deck.
- Flips or diving are not allowed from sides of pool.
- Guests must stay off lane ropes, safety lines and lifeguard stands.
- Loitering is not permitted in or around the Beachwood Family Aquatic Center, including the parking lot.



- Floatation devices including rafts, noodles, water wings, tubes, kickboards, balls, etc. may be limited during busy times.
- Animals are not permitted inside the pool (exceptions: Service Animals).
- Guests are required to ask questions/comments to the manager and not the lifeguard while they are on duty.
- Patrons may be asked to perform a swim test to in order to use deep-water features.
- You may not reserve chairs prior to the pool opening.
- During busy times, management may ask that lounge chairs only be used by adults.

### **WATERSLIDE RULES & REGULATIONS**

- Riders must be at least 48 inches to ride the waterslide. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- The proper riding position is lying on your back with your ankles crossed and arms crossed over your chest. Feet first always
- Single riders only.
- Non-swimmers are not allowed on the drop slide.
- Eyeglasses, sunglasses, hats, goggles, masks, etc must be secured in rider's hands.
- Lifejackets and flotation devices are prohibited on the slide.
- Standing, stopping, flipping or spinning is strictly prohibited while riding the slide.

### **CURRENT CHANNEL RULES & REGULATIONS**

- Enter and exit from the main pool. No jumping in or out while in the channel.
- Children wearing lifejackets or a floatation device must be accompanied by an adult.
- Riders must move with the current during busy times, no hanging on the walls.

### **LAP LANE RULES & REGULATIONS**

- Only patrons swimming laps are allowed in these lanes.
- Lap swimmers must be swimming a proper stroke or exercise drill.
- No stopping in middle of lane or hanging on lane lines.
- No diving off either end of walls.



### **TOT POOL RULES & REGULATIONS**

- Children under 48 inches tall and their guardians only. Age restriction: 6 and under at all times, including rest period.
- Diving from side of pool prohibited.

### **DIVING BOARD RULES & REGULATIONS**

- Dive straight off the end of the diving board. Walk on the board.
- No horseplay allowed on the diving board.
- Make sure the diving area is clear before diving. Do not dive until the previous diver has reached the side of the pool.
- No double bouncing allowed on the diving board.
- Only one guest allowed on the diving board at a time, and on the ladder.
- Do not move the fulcrum of the diving board.
- No patron is allowed to catch a patron jumping off of the diving boards.

### **VORTEX RULES & REGULATIONS**

- Patrons may be required to go with the flow during busy times.
- Lifeguard will determine a safe number of patrons allowed in at one time.

### **INCLEMENT WEATHER RULES & REGULATIONS**

- If thunder is heard or lightening is seen the pool will be cleared. Patrons will remain in safe zone for 30 minutes (time resets each time thunder is heard). All clear is given if no thunder is heard for a 30-minute period.
- The only safe zone is located under the wood awning by the locker rooms and bathrooms, or inside the bathrooms. We ask that all patrons remain in these designated spots until conditions are deemed safe by management.
- In case of heavy rain & thunder/lightning, patrons may be asked to exit deck and remain in bathrooms or sent to their cars.
- See Raincheck policy.



- Warning: failure to follow rules can result in serious injuries.
