Splash Party Rules & Regulations

1. Parties & Pavillion Available to Residents

May be reserved by residents only. Available on Saturdays and Sundays, 12-3 PM or 4-7 PM, June 3 through August 27. The pavilion is included with 8 picnic tables.

2. Fees & Conditions

The Splash Party charge is eighty-five dollars (\$85.00) and includes 10 wristbands. Additional wristbands may be purchased on the day of the party at BFAC for six dollars (\$6.00) each. Existing BFAC members must scan in but do not need a wristband and should not be included in your wristband count. A maximum of fifty (50) wristbands can be purchased for each party. There are no refunds for unused wristbands. Wristbands are date sensitive and are valid for the party date and time only. Splash Party fees must be paid to the City of Beachwood at the time of booking. Parties may only be secured with payment. Availability is limited.

3. Weather & Refund Policy

Splash Parties are non-refundable and nontransferable. However, if the BFAC is closed due to weather or another emergency, a full refund or rescheduling (if possible) will be issued. If a renter chooses to cancel a party for any reason while the BFAC is open, no refunds will be given or rain date assigned. Note: The BFAC will only close in the event of a thunderstorm or other severe weather - it does not close due to slight rain or cooler temperatures.

4. Resident Responsibility

Splash Party reservations must be booked by a Beachwood resident on behalf of the group. Proof of residency is required - a current BFAC Membership or a current utility bill and picture ID. Falsification of residency will result in forfeiture of all fees and cancellation of the party. Only the resident applicant will confer with BFAC employees regarding the party and other arrangements. The resident will be responsible for the payment of the party and other fees, conduct of the group, must be personally present during the entire period of use, and is responsible to the City of Beachwood for any damage or injury which may be caused by the group or any member thereof during the Splash Party.

5. Limit of Two Parties

Households are limited to a maximum of two Splash Parties during the season.

6. Prohibitions

- A. Decorations taped to pavilion columns or picnic tables.
- B. Outside food and/or beverages other than cake.
- C. Loud and disturbing music; loudspeakers; bands or disc jockeys.
- D. Intoxicating substances or illegal drugs.
- E. Gambling.
- F. Solicitation or sales of articles.

7. Clean-up

Splash Party groups are responsible for clean-up of their litter and other debris and for any damage to city property and facilities. Any signs, posters, etc., must be removed upon conclusion of the party

8. Violation

Violation of these Rules and Regulations will result in possible prosecution and other appropriate legal action and will result in loss of future reservation privileges with Beachwood Community Services.
